#### PART 1. GENERAL

#### 1.1 COMPETITIVE COST SEALED BIDS

Sealed bids for construction of the Benjamin Hawkins Parkway Water System Improvements will be received until <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>December 17th</u>, <u>2024</u> at <u>2:00 PM</u> at the Byron Municipal Complex, 401 Main Street, Byron, Georgia 31008, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Any bid received after said time and date will not be considered by the Owner. No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days except as specifically may be provided in the Instructions to Bidders and/or by State law.

## 1.2 SCOPE OF WORK

This project shall include furnishing all products and performing all labor necessary to construct the following: installation of +/- 5,600 L.F. of 12" PVC Water Main, +/- 200 L.F of Jack & Bore steel casing to be bored under Benjamin Hawkins Parkway, and +/- 150 L.F. of Jack & Bore steel casing to be bored under Norfolk Southern Right-of-Way along with the installation of new fire hydrants, gate valves, and all other appurtenances necessary to complete the project in accordance with the specifications and construction drawings.

Time allotted for completion of work is <u>180</u> consecutive calendar days. All Work shall be completed in accordance with the plans and specifications. The Work will be awarded in **one** (1) Contract.

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## 1.4 CONTRACTOR LICENSE

The Scope of Work as described herein is defined as "utility contracting" in accordance with O.C.G.A 43-14-2(17) so the Contractor performing the work must provide proof of a valid license by the State of Georgia as a "Utility Contractor" and must also employ a "Utility Manager" certification holder who will have oversight of all utility the work. See Instruction to Bidders for additional bidding requirements.

## 1.5 BONDS

Bids shall be accompanied by a bid bond or certified cashier's check in an amount not less than 5% of the base bid. All bonds shall be by a surety company licensed in Georgia with an "A" minimum rating of performance and a financial strength of at least five (5) times the contract price as listed in the most current publication of "Best's Key Rating Guide Property Liability". Performance and Payment Bonds, each in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price shall be required of the successful bidder if contract is awarded. Each Bond shall be accompanied by a "Power of Attorney" authorizing the attorney-in-fact to bind the surety and certified to include the date of the bond.

This project (EDA Investment No. 04-79-07758) will be partially funded with Federal funds from the United States Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration and therefore is subject to the Federal laws and regulations associated with that program. All Bidders must comply with 41 CFR 60-4, in regard to affirmative action, to ensure equal opportunity to females and minorities and will apply the timetables and goals set forth in 41 CFR 60-4, as applicable to the area of the project, including existing State public works construction requirements. Applicable Federal requirements, including Davis-Bacon Wage Rates, are included in the contract documents.

#### 1.10 RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, including without limitation, the rights to reject any or all nonconforming, nonresponsive, unbalanced or conditional Bids and to reject the Bid of any Bidder if Owner believes that it would not be in the best interest of the Project to make an award to that Bidder, whether because the Bid is not responsive or the Bidder is unqualified or of doubtful financial ability or fails to meet any other pertinent standard or criteria established by the Owner.
